2013 City of Brighton Election Process

Residents interested in running for Mayor or City Council positions for the November 5, 2013 municipal election may pick up petition packets at City Hall in the Office of the City Clerk, 500 South 4th Avenue, 4th floor from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. beginning Aug. 6. Petitions must be filed with the City Clerk by 5 p.m. on Aug. 26.

Open seats for the 2013 election include: Mayor and one council seat in each of the city's four wards - Ward 1, Ward 2, Ward 3, and Ward 4.

Qualified candidates can run for Mayor (elected at large) or council member of the ward they reside in. Candidates must be: a United States citizen; at least 18 years of age; a qualified elector of the City of Brighton for at least one year prior to the election date; a resident of the applicable ward if running for a ward position; possess the ability to serve a four-year term, or until a successor is elected; not currently a City of Brighton employee and has not been convicted of a felony.
