

CITY OF BRIGHTON FESTIVAL OF LIGHTS PARADE MINIMUM LIGHTING REQUIREMENTS

**The Festival of Lights Parade is a night-time electrical parade.
Every parade entry must meet the minimum lighting requirements!**

PLEASE NOTE: ALL ENTRIES MUST PROVIDE ONE PERSON OVER THE AGE OF 18 (WALKING) WHO WILL BE THAT ENTRY'S "NUMBER CARRIER". THIS PERSON MUST BE LIT WITH A MINIMUM OF 60 LIGHTS ON THEIR BODY!!! (The City of Brighton Special Events office will provide the 11" x 17" entry number card when you check-in.)

Walking Entries (Walking Groups, Marching Bands, and Number Carriers)

All individual **walkers (including animals)** must be illuminated with lights, using battery pack and fluorescent materials. The following height/lighting requirements should be used:

	Height	# of Lights/Walker
Walkers	Up to 2 feet tall	20
Walkers	2 to 4 feet tall	40
Walkers	4 Feet tall and up	60

Equine/Livestock Entries (Ridden and Driven Entries)

Equine/livestock entries must be illuminated as follows. **Please note that on driven entries, both the animal and the hitch or trailer must be lit!**

	Type of Entry	# of Lights/Person	# of Lights/Animal	# of Lights/Trailer or Hitch
Equine/Livestock	Ridden Entry	20	40	--
Equine/Livestock	Driven Entry, Hitch or Trailer up to 10 feet long	--	40	750
Equine/Livestock	Driven Entry, Hitch or Trailer over 10 feet long	--	40	1,000

Motorized Entries

	Type of Entry	# of Lights/Vehicle
Motorized	Cars (including Rod/Custom Vehicles)	1,000
Motorized	Trucks (including Rod/Custom Vehicles)	2,000
Motorized	Fire Trucks	6,000
Motorized	Heavy Equipment	6,000

Floats (including Semi-truck+Trailer Combos)

Please note that both the towing vehicle AND the float must be lit!

	Type of Towing Vehicle	# of Lights/Towing Vehicle	Hitch/Trailer/Float Platform Length	# of Lights/Float
Float	Car	1,000	Up to 10 Feet Long	1,000
Float	Truck	2,000	Up to 10 Feet Long	1,000
Float	Truck	2,000	10 - 15 Feet Long	2,000
Float	Truck	2,000	15 Feet and Longer	4,000
