VOLUNTEER SIGN-UP

YOUR JOB "As a Team Captain"

- Recruit a team of 8 to 15 people (*from your office, church, family, club, bowling team, whatever...*) Please be sure volunteers are 14 years of age or older. Younger children may participate, but must be directly supervised by a parent/guardian.
- Provide ladders and any paint tools you could donate to the project. (*Brushes, scrapers, rollers, roller pans, drop cloths, etc.*) Also any supplement tools needed for project
- Attend the Team Captain Meeting on **Tuesday, May 3 at 6:30 pm** at the Eagle View Adult Center, 1150 Prairie Center Parkway. At this meeting you will select the project for your team.
- Meet with the homeowner, inspect the project and allow for any advance preparation work.
- Show-up Saturday, May 14 from 8:00 am - 3:30 pm with your team, ready to go!

OUR JOB

- Ensure that homeowner meets income guidelines.
- Screen property for need and size of project.
- Confer with homeowner on materials, paint colors, determine quantity of paint required per house and any other materials required.
- Assign a home to each volunteer or volunteer team.
- Provide materials, paint, supervision and most tools.
- Inspect the completed home and pick up unused supplies.
